



CHECK LIST

Submitting your work

Carefully review the GUIDE for all compliances.

- 25 images, black & white and/or color and must be a minimum of 11"x14" and a maximum of 20"x20" on mounts suitable for ASP's display at the PPA Imaging USA Convention
- Images should be impeccably printed, mounted and presented and only use titles or legends on the front of the image, if it's an integral part of the image
- Name, address, title and image number (arranged and numbered 1-25 in display sequence) order is to appear on the back of each image. No evidence of previous judging is permitted, along with a printed title sheet and image layout (how you want the twenty-five images presented).
- Thesis, should not be less than 2,000 words, with resume and bio at the back of the Thesis (Bio not included in count). 6 bound copies, neatly presented in binder, book or folder.
- Current ASP dues and last 3 years in ASP have been paid.
- \$150 application fee (*July 1st*) and balance of \$150 with Thesis (*Aug 9th*) or Portfolio (*Aug 17th*).
- A copy of your PPA Merit list, with your Print Merits and the 15 Print Merits you attained after your Master's degree highlighted. To confirm merits, check PPA website <<http://www.ppa.com>>
- Included a CD or DVD of your portfolio images, in JPEG format (.jpg), a current headshot, family shot and the digital format of your Thesis in Microsoft Word (.doc) or text (.txt) format.
- Ship Portfolio images in metal case is recommended for maximum protection. If you ship your images in any serviceable box, your images will not be returned.

- Review the official ASP FELLOWSHIP GUIDE for all procedures and rules.
Non-compliance with the Guide rules by an applicant may be subject to disqualification by the Chairman and Judging Committee.

Application **July 1st**
Thesis Deadline **August 9th**
Portfolio Deadline **August 17th**
